

# STEP BACK IN TIME AT EDEN CAMP MODERN HISTORY MUSEUM

In 1942, 250 Italian prisoners of war constructed a Prisoner of War Camp that could hold over 1,000 prisoners at a time. By the summer of 1944, as the Allies advanced in Normandy, German POWs replaced the Italian POWs. These men, like their predecessors, worked farms locally and called Eden Camp home until 1948 – three years after the War ended.

Today, you can explore 22 of the original Prisoner of War huts, each transformed into immersive exhibits that capture the spirit and struggles of the Second World War. Step into wartime Britain and experience the sights, sounds, and even smells of the era.





**BY TRAIN:** The nearest station is 2.2 miles away in Malton, with bus or taxi options available.
